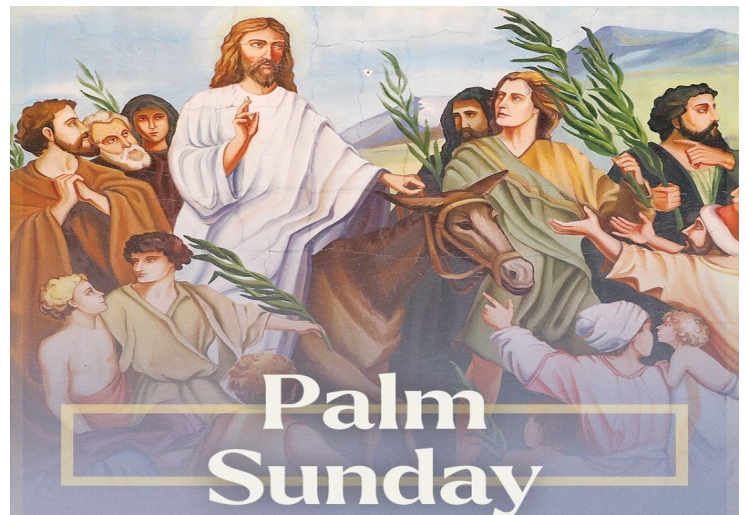

Maundy Thursday Foot Washing Volunteers Needed:

It is a ritual that signifies our participation in Christ's mission of love and service to one another and to those in need in our world today.

A Minute with Jesus:

Jesus is the "Living Bread from Heaven."

Jesus said, "I am the living bread that came down from Heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever." (John 6:51). Jesus gave this living bread for the first time to His Apostles at the Last Supper. Jesus gives this living Bread to us in Holy Communion. The living Bread is Jesus Himself.

Let's pray this right now and every day this week: Jesus, please strengthen my faith to believe that You are the "living Bread" received in Holy Communion.

This week, read the explanation that Jesus gives that He is the "living Bread from Heaven" in John 6: 48-51

Lent: Pray the Sign of the Cross more reverently

The sign of the cross is a prayer and there is so much to this sign. To hand on the Catholic Faith as our ancestors have done, let us pray with our children at home in the morning, at mealtime and at bedtime, and especially about important decisions, beginning prayer with the sign of the cross.
