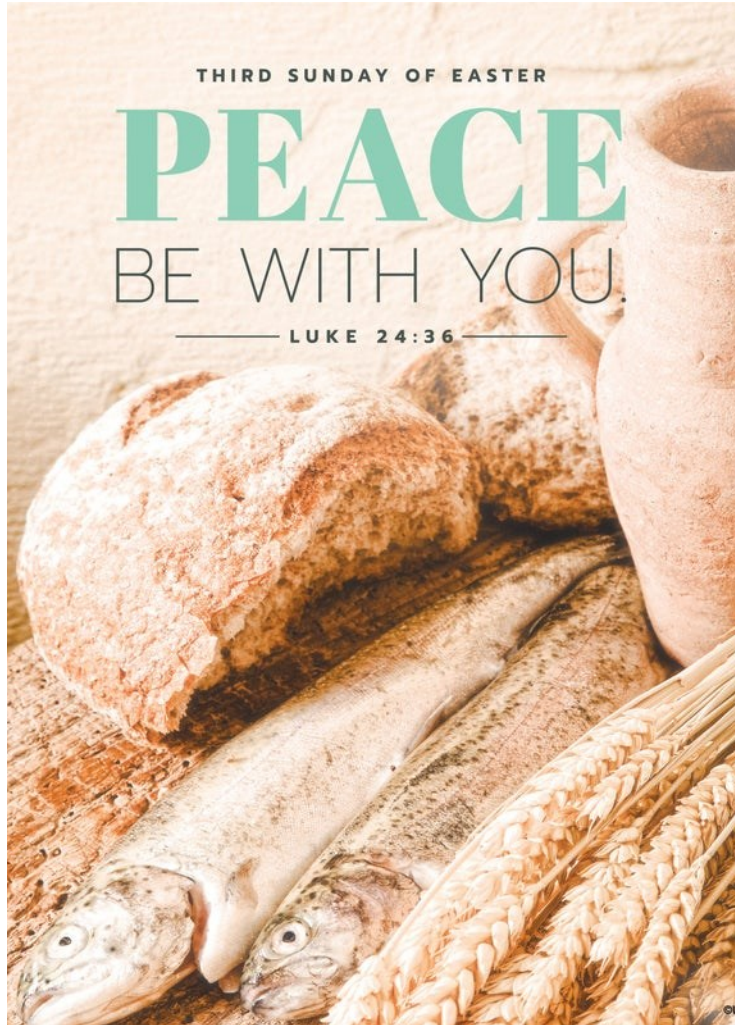

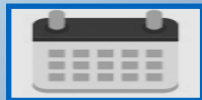

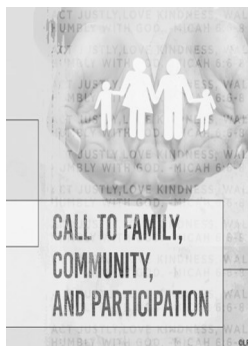
A Minute with Jesus

The Eucharist is the Risen Christ

On Easter Sunday, two disciples were leaving Jerusalem without hope as they believed that the Savior was dead. Jesus joined them as they walked but the disciples did not recognize Him as He now had a glorified body. When Jesus sat down with the disciples at Emmaus, they recognized Him in the "breaking of bread," which was the Eucharist.

Let's pray this right now and every day this week: Lord, make my heart burn with a desire to read Your Word in Sacred Scripture.

This week, read how Jesus explained how He fulfilled the Old Testament in His Passion, Death and Resurrection, and allowed the disciples to recognize Him in the breaking of the bread in Luke 24:13-35.

U.S. Bishops call for Prayer to St. Joseph ahead of Supreme Court ruling on Abortion Pill

The U.S. Bishops are inviting Catholics to join a focused effort of prayer to St. Joseph for “the end of abortion and the protection of women and preborn children” starting on March 25, through June, when a decision of the court is expected. Josephine's Journey A benefit event for Josephine Habeck Sunday, April 28, 2024 11:00-5:00 Rosholt Fairgrounds

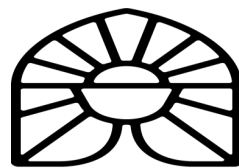
