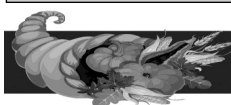
St. Joseph Church & Rectory Cleaning

PASTOR'S CORNER

Dedication of the Lateran Basilica
 "Where 2 or 3 Are Gathered..." Matthew 18:20

- For the first three centuries, Christians did not have formal church buildings- they gathered in "house churches".
- Early Christians met in the homes of wealthy members to share instruction, celebrate the sacraments, and break bread in celebration of the Eucharist. These houses had biblical roots: Jesus taught that "where 2 or 3 are gathered in my name, there am I in their midst."
- St. Paul wrote: "The Churches of Asia send you greetings. Aquila and Prisca together with the Church at their home send you many greetings in the Lord." (1Cor 16:19)
- In the 4th century, Roman Emperor Constantine legalized Christianity, creating a need to construct or take over large buildings to accommodate the rapidly growing number of Christians. These became the first permanent churches; the 1st of which is the Lateran Basilica. They were patterned after public buildings of the time, especially the basilica (a Greek word meaning "royal house").
- Even in these much larger buildings, the hope was that the spirit of the house church would remain with the community and in the fellowship.
- May that spirit remain with St. Joseph Church, Galloway and St. Ladislaus Church, Bevent. Amen.
